

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different Funeral Directors (because prices can vary).

<p>ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral Director's charges only)</p> <p>This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.</p> <p>Our Professional Fees include:</p> <p>Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements and offering the choice of meeting in branch, your home or arranging online/phone, with follow-up meetings required</p> <p>Collecting and transporting the deceased person from place of death (within 25 miles radius) into our care at Zoe Turnbull Funeral Directors, 6 Market Place, Jedburgh, TD8 6AP every day of the year with no additional charge for out of hours</p> <p>Care of the deceased person including dressing before the funeral in our premises</p> <p>Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from light oak veneer</p> <p>Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment (by law a fee is listed but we do not charge for this service)</p> <p>At a date and time you agree with the Funeral Director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 25 miles radius) in a hearse</p>	<p>£1645</p> <p>£325</p> <p>£275</p> <p>£395</p> <p>£1</p> <p>£395</p>
<p>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</p> <p>This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</p> <p>Burial (Funeral Director's charges only)</p> <p>Cremation (Funeral Director's charges plus the Cremation Fee)</p>	<p>£2875</p> <p>£2095</p>
<p>FEES YOU MUST PAY</p> <p>For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the Burial Fee (or interment fee charged for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave). In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:</p> <p>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee.
